

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

If you do not feel comfortable installing your **Thumper Fab** Subwoofer Mount, please see your nearest Can Am[®] Dealer for installation.

Installation Preperation

Flip the center seat up to gain access to the 2 OEM mounting bolts. Remove these 2 mounting bolts using a 13mm socket and 13mm wrench (**FIG 1**).

With the seat removed from the vehicle, use a T20 Torx to remove the 4 OEM seat frame mounting screws. Set the frame aside as it will no longer be used (**FIG 2**).

Installation

Fasten the Seat Bracket (3) to the underside of the seat using 2 x unthreaded spacers (\mathbf{C}), 2 x #10 x 1-1/2" phillips head screws (\mathbf{D}), and 2 x 1/4" flat washers (\mathbf{E}) using a drill with phillips head bit. First place 2 x spacers (\mathbf{C}) in area shown below, followed by bracket (3), 2 x flat washers (\mathbf{E}), then 2 x screws (\mathbf{D}).

Installation

Fasten the Lower Bracket (1), the L-Bracket (2), and the Seat Bracket (3) to the subwoofer using 12 x M6-1.0x16mm pan head torx screws (A) with a T30 Torx and place into position to mark the Lower Bracket (1) position (FIG 6).




FIG 7 - Mark position of Lower Bracket using a Pencil or Marker

Use a pencil or marker to mark the position of the Lower Bracket (1) to allow for realignment and fastening of bracket to the floor. Once outer profile of bracket is marked, take the subwoofer assembly out of the unit and set aside (**FIG 7**).

Installation

With the subwoofer assembly removed from the unit, place the Lower Bracket into position by aligning the bracket with the pencil marks made in the previous step. Using the Lower Bracket as a template, drill an 1/8" pilot hole, then use 2 x #14 x 3/4" truss head screws (**B**) to fasten the Lower Bracket (**1**) to the floor of the unit using a drill and phillips head bit (**FIG 8**).

Reinstall the subwoofer assembly into the unit, replacing the 4 x pan head torx screws ($\bf A$) that fasten the Lower Bracket ($\bf 1$) to the subwoofer. Using the L-Bracket as a template, drill a pilot hole with an 1/8" drill bit. Then use 1 x #14 x 3/4" truss head screw to fasten L-Bracket to the floor of the unit using a drill (**FIG 9**). Refer to wiring instructions provided inside the subwoofer box.
