



Install D-Foam

Cut the D-foam **Ref C** in half, so that both pieces are equal length. Install the D-foam where shown in **Figure 2**. Cut off any loose material.



Remove the Nuts from Spacer Bolts

On the front of the roof, remove the 5/16" nyloc nuts **Ref H** and the 5/16" flat washers **Ref G** from the 5/16" x 1-1/2" bolts **Ref E**. Do not remove the 1/2" spacers **Ref I** which should stay on the roof.

Remove the Stock Roof (if applicable)

The stock polyroof is held on by push pins and shouldn't require any tools to remove. Remove the stock roof and set it aside.

Install the Z-Brackets

Position the Z-brackets **Ref A** on the ROPS(roll-over protection system, a.k.a. the roll cage) on the rear corner, as shown in **Figure 2**.



Install the Vertical Bar Clamp On Roof(if applicable)

Install the vertical bar clamp **Ref B** on the audio roof, as shown in **Figure 4**. Before continuing to the next step, use the 9/64" hex drive to remove the bottom half of the bar clamp to place over the ROPS.



Place Audio Roof on Unit

With the help of two people, place the audio roof on top of the ROPS and align the mounting holes between the audio roof and the ROPS. Make sure that the 5/16" x 1-1/2" bolts **Ref E** go through the holes on the ROPS.

Tighten Down the Roof to Spec

Use the torque wrench with the 1/2" socket to tighten down the rear hardware to **10FT-LBS**. Overtighening may cause gaps where water can enter the roof and damage the electronics. Then install the other half of the bar clamp using the 9/64" hex drive. Finally, tighten the hardware **Ref H** at the front of the roof using the 1/2" socket, making sure to include the 5/16" flat washers **Ref G**.

Wiring the Audio Roof

Lift up the back seat to gain access to the electrical compartment. Strip the last 1/2" of sheathing on the wires and use the crimping tool to add a 3/8" ring terminal to one side of the 40A inline fuse **Ref D**. Use the butt connector to connect the other side of the fuse to the wiring harness on the audio roof. Connect the ring terminals to the battery using the 10mm socket. Correct wiring is shown in **Figure 5**. **Note: incorrectly connecting the wires may result in damage to the vehicle or audio roof.**


