

# **Polaris Ranger XP1000** Fender Flares

#### **Installation Preperation**

Fasten the front upper and lower fender flare together using  $4 \times 1/4$ " x 3/4" button head screws, and  $4 \times 1/4$ " nylon lock nuts (**FIG 1**).

Use the front fender flare as a template to locate the holes to be drilled by holding the flare in position and drilling one hole into the plastics through the flare using a 5/16" drill bit. Once one hole is drilled, insert a panel clip through the flare into the drilled hole to hold the fender flare in position before drilling the remaining holes (**FIG 2**).

#### **Installation Preperation**

As the remainder of the holes are drilled, install panel clips in new holes to hold the fender flare in the proper position before moving onto next hole to drill (**FIG 3**).




FIG 4 - Fasten Logo Plates to Rear Upper Fender Flares

Fasten the logo plates to the rear upper fender flare using  $4 \times 1/8$ " rivets (**FIG 4**).

#### Installation

Use the rear upper and rear lower fender flares as templates to locate the holes to be drilled. Repeat the procedure from the front fender flare installation by drilling one hole through the flare into the plastic and installing panel clips as new holes are drilled to hold fender flare in proper position. When drilling for the driver side rear lower flare, be cautious of the fuel tank located behind the plastics (**FIG 5**).

Use panel clips to fasten the fender flares to the vehicle by feeding the clips through the fender flares into the drilled holes (**FIG 6**).
