



- Press UNIBALL into BALL JOINT HOUSING

 Install LOCK NUT over UNIBALL PIN

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Secure the Ranger on Jack Stands

With the Ranger secured on the jack stands, remove the front bumper and tires. Remove the brake line mounting bolts from the factory control arms and remove the brake caliper, hub, knuckle, and control arms. Retain factory hardware for installation of forward arms (**FIG 1**).

Install the Lower Front Forward Arm

Using the factory hardware install the TF lower front forward arm. Tighten (**FIG 2**). Use the die grinder with a carbide burr to clearance the knuckle in the area shown until the lower uniball pin slips into the knuckle (**FIG 3**).

Using an 18mm socket, tighten the lower uniball pin to knuckle (FIG 4).

Mount the upper arm using factory harware. Tighten using a 18mm socket and 18mm wrench. Be sure to properly route brake line to be attached to bottom of upper arm by zip ties (**C**) (**FIG 5**).

Using an 15mm socket and 15mm wrench, tighten factory cross bolt to secure upper uniball pin to the knuckle (**FIG 6**).

Apply anti seize to the splined end of the axle, then slide the hub assembly over the axle (**FIG 7**).

Using an 15mm socket and the factory hardware with blue loctitie applied to threads to mount the brake caliper to the knuckle (FIG 8).



FIG 8 - Mount brake caliper to knuckle using factory bolts and a 15mm Socket




FIG 9 - Fasten sway bar and shock to upper arm using factory hardware and 15mm Socket

Mount sway bar and shock to upper control arm using factory hardware with 15mm socket and 15mm wrench (**FIG 9**).

Install Steering Stop






FIG 10 - Cut clamp and slide Boot back

Locate and cut the inner clamp that holds the steering boot onto the steering rack (**FIG 10**). Slide the boot back and install the steering stop (**A**) onto the worm gear on both sides of the steering rack. Use the provided 9mm clamps (**B**) to reseal the steering boot (**FIG 11**).

Fasten outter tie rod end to knuckle using factory nut and 18mm socket. Tighten factory axle nut and washer using 27 mm socket, install cotter pin through factory axle nut (**FIG 12**).

Clamp Brake Lines

Use the provided zip ties to attach the brake line to the underside of the upper control arm at the provided brake line tab. Pay special attention to make sure brake line will not contact axle (**FIG 13**).

IF YOU ARE USING A FACTORY BUMPER

Reinstall the front bumper to mark the front bumper to show where to lower control arm would contact factory bumper use a grinder/cutoff wheel to trim to allow for maximum control arm travel. Apply touch up paint if necessary (**FIG 14**).

Remove bumper, once the material has been removed from the bumper, reinstall bumper and verify adequate clearance to allow for maximum control arm extension without bumper contact (**FIG 15**).

Reinstall wheels and bumper, lower the unit to the ground and adjust toe as needed (**FIG 16**).
