
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



Press in UNIBALL into HOUSING.
Install INTERNAL RETAINING RIING.

3. Insert UNIBALL PIN into UNIBALL.

4. Install MISALIGNMENT onto threaded end of UNIBALL PIN.

5 Thread and tighten LOCKNUT onto UNIBALL PIN.

Removal of the Factory Control Arms

Note: Pictures take place on passenger side. Process is the same for driver and passenger side.

Remove the Front Tires

Place the UTV into park. Use a jack and jackstands to lift and secure the UTV, then remove the tires.

Remove the Lower Shock Mount Bolt

Use a 15mm wrench and 15mm socket to remove the lower shock mounting bolt (**FIG 1**). Once the bolt is removed and the shock is able to swing upward, tie the shock up and out of the way for control arm removal and replacement (**FIG 2**).

Unmount Brake Line

Use a flathead screwdriver to pry brake line out of mounting brackets so that the brake line is fully detached from upper control arm (**FIG 3**).

Remove the Brake Caliper

Use a 15mm socket to remove the brake calipers and slide the calipers inside the Frame of the UTV behind the radiator so the caliper and brake line is out of the way for control arm removal and replacement.

Unfasten the Upper Ball Joint and Sway Bar Link

Use a 15mm socket and 15mm wrench to remove the upper ball joint securing bolt and the bolt fastening the front sway bar link to the upper control arm (**FIG 4**).

Remove the Upper Control Arm

Use a 18mm socket and 18mm wrench to remove the 2 upper control arm mounting bolts that attach the arm to the frame (**FIG 5**).

Remove Lower Control Arm

Use a 15mm socket and 15mm wrench to remove the lower ball joint securing bolt to the hub assembly. Use an 18mm socket and 18mm wrench to remove the 2 control arm mounting bolts that attach control arm to frame (**FIG 6**).



FIG 6 - Remove Lower Control Arm using 15mm Socket, 18mm Socket and 18mm Wrench Install Polaris General Steering Stop

Locate and cut the inner zip tie that holds the steering boot in place (**FIG 8**). Pull back the steering boot and install the Polaris steering stop (**B**) onto the worm gear of both sides of the steering rack. Use the provided zip tie (**A**) to reseal the steering boot (**FIG 9**).

Install New Forward arms

Install new forward control arms in the reverse order as shown in the instructions for removal of control arms.

Install Brake Line mounting Zip Ties

Use provided zip ties (A) to fasten the brake line to the upper control arm in the provided brake line fastening slot (**FIG 10**).

FYI - Stock Ball Joints are Compatible with Rock Guard, Trim or Remove Rock Guard if Running Keller or Uniball Ball Joints

Check Toe Alignment

Check the toe and realign steering if necessary. Torque all fasteners to factory specifications.

Reattach the Front Tires

Reattach the front tires and torque lug nuts to factory specifications. Remove the jackstands and lower the UTV to the ground.
