

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

If you do not feel comfortable installing your **Thumper Fab** HEADACHE RACK, please see your nearest CAN-AM® Dealer for installation.

Installation Preparation

Fasten the rear panel to the headache rack frame using 7 x M8x20mm flange head bolts. Tighten using a 13mm socket. Trim can be placed in between the rear panel and the headache rack frame to eliminate any rattling (**FIG 1 & FIG 2**).

Fasten the manual winch control switch to the rear panel using hardware provided in the winch box (**FIG 3**).

Installation Preparation

Loosley fasten the lower mount brackets to the headache rack frame using 6 x M8x45mm button head screws and 6 x M8 nylon lock nuts. Loosley tighten using a 5mm allen wrench and a 13mm socket (**FIG 4**).




FIG 5 - Fasten Fairlead to the Headache Rack Frame

Fasten the fairlead to the headache rack frame using hardware provided in the winch box (**FIG 5**).

Installation Preperation

Fasten the winch to the headache rack frame using 4 X M6x16mm flange head bolts and 4 X M6 lock washers. Tighten using a 10mm socket (**FIG 6**).



FIG 6 - Fasten Winch to the Headache Rack Frame




FIG 7 - Fasten Winch Hook and Winch Stop to the Winch Cable

Fasten the winch stop and the winch hook to the winch cable using hardware provided in the winch box (**FIG 7**).

Installation Preperation




FIG 8 - Raise the Dump Bed to fully open position

Raise the bed to the fully open position to prepare for placement and installation of the headache rack (**FIG 8**).

DEFENDER HD11 (ONLY) - Trim the plastic as shown below in preparation for mounting the headache rack to the vehicle using a pencil grinder or box knife (**FIG 9**).

Installation Preperation

Hold the headache rack into place and use 4 x M8-1.25 x 20mm flange bolts with 4 x M8 fender washers and 13mm socket to fasten the headache rack to the upper holes in the roll cage. Do not fully tighten. If the unit also has a Thumper Fab Audio Roof, use supplied 4 x M8-1.25 x 45mm flange bolts (F) instead. (FIG 10).

Installation

Fasten the lower mount brackets to the vehicle using 4 X M8x20mm flange head bolts. Tighten using a 13mm socket before fully tightening the 4 upper mounting bolts (**FIG 11**).

With all mounting hardware tight, fully tighten the lower mounting bracket hardware that fastens the lower brackets to the headache rack frame (**FIG 12**).

Winch Wiring

Remove the twist release pins holding the battery cover on under the passenger side rear seat. Remove the cover and set it off to the side (**FIG 13**).




FIG 14 - Winch Wiring Diagram

Do not refer to wiring instructions contained in the winch box as it is not suitable for this application. Reference the following wiring diagram for wiring instructions for the winch (FIG 14).

Winch Wiring

Use a pencil grinder to remove this plastic seam so that the winch control box will mount flat against the back face of the panel above the battery (**FIG 15**).



FIG 15 - Grind down plastic lip for Winch Control Box

Fasten the winch control box to the plastic panel above the battery using 2 X #10x1/2" pointed screws (**FIG 16**).

Winch Wiring (HD11 ONLY)




FIG 17 - Mount location for winch contactor box (HD11 ONLY)

Mount the winch contactor box as shown (under the center rear seat) using $2 \times \#10 \times 1/2$ " pointed screws (**FIG 17**).

Winch Wiring

Fasten the wires to the winch using a 10mm socket. Connect the wire with a blue lead to the blue terminal and the wire with a yellow lead to the yellow terminal (**FIG 18**).

Attach the red and black wire from the winch control box to the positive and negative terminal of the battery. Connect the blue and black wires from the winch contactor box to the blue and black connectors on the manual winch switch wiring harness. Route the single red wire from the winch manual switch harness in the floor tunnel towards the dash and connect it to the red terminal of the busbar located behind the center dash switch panel (**FIG 19**).

Install Cube Lights (Optional)

Attach cube lights to the mount brackets using the hardware and brackets inside the light box (**FIG 20 & FIG 21**).

Using the hardware provided in the cube light box, fasten the cube light to the headache rack. Use the provided slots found in the winch mount plate to zip tie the cube light wires to the headache rack (**FIG 22 & FIG 23**)

Wiring Harness




FIG 24 - Wiring Harness Breakdown of Plugs and Terminals

Wiring harness provided to power your cube lights includes a switch and terminals for connection to power and ground terminals (FIG 24).

Pull back the factory switch panel in the dash of your Defender to gain access to the accesory power and ground terminals. Connect the red wire to the red terminal and the black wire to the black terminal (FIG 25).

Wiring Harness

Select a slot in the dash for your switch. Wires should be as shown below, black on top, white in the middle, and blue on bottom. Snap switch into dash (**FIG 26 & FIG 27**).
