



PARTS



Installation Preparation

Use a T25 Torx to remove the dome light from the front headliner and disconnect the wiring harness from the back side of the light (**FIG 1 & FIG 2**).



FIG 1 & FIG 2 - Remove Dome Light

Use a T40 Torx to remove the 4 X OEM bolts that mount the front upper switch panel to the inside of the vehicle. Save this bolts as they will be reused later on in the installation process (**FIG 3**).



FIG 3 - Loosen Front - Upper Switch Panel

Installation Preparation




FIG 4 - Remove Front Headliner

Use a panel clip removal tool to remove the panel clips that fasten the front section of the headliner to the vehicle. With all panel clips removed, take front section of headliner out of the vehicle and set aside for later use (**FIG 4**).






FIG 5 & FIG 6 - Remove Bolts and Panel Clips that fasten Rear Headliner

Use a T25 Torx to remove the 2 X OEM bolts that fasten the rear corners of the rear headliner to the underside of the roof (**FIG 5**). Additionally, remove the panel clips that hold the rear portion of the headliner up and remove from vehicle (**FIG 6**). Rear window clamps will need to be rotated to pull the rear headliner out of the vehicle (**FIG 7**).

Installation Preperation

BE CAREFUL NOT TO LET THE REAR WINDOW FALL OUT OF THE VEHILCE.



FIG 7 - Rotated Rear Window Clamp




FIG 8 - Remove Internal Roof Mounting Clamps

Using a 10mm socket, remove the 4 X OEM internal roof mounting clamps that fasten the underside of the roof to the vehicle (**FIG 8**).

Installation Preperation

With a flathead screwdriver or similar tool, disconnect the various wiring harnesses from the underside of the roof and allow the harnesses to hang down to ensure that no wires are still connected to the inside of the roof (**FIG 9**).



FIG 9 - Unfasten Wiring Harnesses from inside of Roof




FIG 10 - Remove OEM Roof Mounting Bolts

With a 13mm socket, remove the 8 X OEM roof mounting bolts located on top of the roof (**FIG 10**).

Installation Preperation

Remove and set aside the 8 X OEM roof grommets as they will be reused during the installation of the Thumper Fab Audio Roof (**FIG 11**).



FIG 11 - Remove and set aside Roof Grommets

Remove the 6 X OEM windshield hinge mounting bolts using a 10mm socket. The help of another person is suggested to support the windshield during the removal process (**FIG 12**).

Installation Preparation

Disconnect the wiring harness going to the windshield wiper motor as well as the windshield wiper fluid feed line (**FIG 13**).




FIG 14 - Disconnect Gas Shocks and remove Windshield

Disconnect the gas shocks from the windshield and set the windshield aside for reinstallation in a later step (**FIG 14**).

Installation Preparation

Use a T25 Torx to remove the bed light from the rear of the roof and disconnect the wiring harness from the back of the light. Set aside as it will be reused for installation (**FIG 15 & FIG 16**).

Remove the 4 X OEM bolts located under the front brow of the roll cage using a 10mm socket (**FIG 17**).



FIG 17 - Remove the remaining Roof Mounting bolts (Front)

Installation Preparation




FIG 18 - Remove the OEM Roof

Remove the OEM roof and set aside (FIG 18).

Use 2 self tapping screws to fasten the rear pulse bar to the top of the roll cage near the passenger C-Pillar. Slide the foam back to gain access to the roll cage tube for more secure mounting (**FIG 19 & FIG 20**).

Installation

Loosen the 2 X outer OEM bolts at the fronter center section of the roll cage using a 15mm socket. Slide front mount bracket down on the 2 X OEM bolts and loosley tighten (**FIG 21 & FIG 22**).




FIG 23 - Remove the Rear Bed Light from Front Siwtch Panel

Unplug and remove the rear bed light switch from the front switch panel using a small flathead screwdriver to disengage the small prongs that hold the switch in place in the front switch panel (**FIG 23**).

Installation




FIG 24 - Replace OEM Cage Bolts

Remove and replace the 2 X OEM flange head bolts and flange head lock nuts located on the center cross tube of the roll cage using a 17mm socket and 15mm wrench. Replace the OEM bolts with the M10x70mm hex head bolts and 2 X M10 flat washers. Tighten using OEM lock nuts (**FIG 24**).




FIG 25 & FIG 26 - Fasten Switch Mount to Roll Cage Bolts

With the replacement roll cage bolts properly torqued, slide the switch mount over the excess threads followed by 2 X M10 nylon lock nuts. Loosley fasten lock nuts using a 17mm socket. **Do not overtighten as switch mount is plastic and will crack if overtightened** (**FIG 25 & FIG 26**).

Installation




FIG 27 - Plug Bed Light Harness into Switch

Plug the bed light harness into the back of the switch with the wiring routed over the roll cage as shown below (**FIG 27**).

Plug the extension harness into the female connector for the windshield wiper motor. Route the harness along the path shown below with the female end of the extension harness ending near the rear view mirror location (**FIG 28**).

Installation

Fasten any remaining harnesses that are hanging down in the rear section of the cab using zip ties to hold the harnesses to the rear support tubes (**FIG 29**).



FIG 29 - Tie up any loose wiring harnesses

Plug the holes in the front of the roll cage using the rubber plugs provided in the hardware kit (**FIG 30**).

Installation




FIG 31 & 32 - Trim and install Tape on Center Seam and Holes

Trim the tape provided in the hardware kit to seal the seam and holes in the front center section of the roll cage. Remove the adhesive backing and install the tape so that it covers the seam and holes completely (FIG 31 & FIG 32).

Mount the bed light to the Thumper Fab Audio Roof using 2 X 1/4"x3/4" button head screws and 2 X 1/4" nylon lock nuts. Tighten using a 5/32" allen wrench and a 7/16" wrench (**FIG 33 & FIG 34**).

Installation




FIG 35 - Install Foam Trim on Roof

Install foam trim along driver and passenger side of roof before installing roof assembly on top of vehicle (FIG 35).

Place the roof on the vehicle and use the M8 bolts and 8 X M8 fender washers provided in the hardware kit along with the OEM roof grommets to loosley fasten the roof to the roll cage (**FIG 36**).

Installation

Fasten the roof to the front mounting using 6 X M6x30mm button flange screws and 6 X M6 bonded washers (**ON THE OUTSIDE OF VEHICLE**), and 6 X M6 fender washers with 6 X M6 flange nylon lock nuts (**ON THE INSIDE OF VEHICLE**). Loosley tighten using a 10mm socket and a 4mm allen wrench (**FIG 37**).



FIG 37 - Fasten Roof to Front Mount Bracket

Reinstall the windshield using the OEM hardware. Tighten using a 10mm socket. Plug in the windshield wiper motor and reconnect the washer fluid feed line (**FIG 38**).

Installation

Route the power wire from the roof towards the battery compartment located under the passenger rear seat. Zip tie the power wire to the roll cage along the path to the passenger C-Pillar and route the wire down the pillar towards the battery compartment (**FIG 39 & FIG 40**).




FIG 41 & FIG 42 - Connect Power Wire to Breaker and Breaker and ground wire to Battery

Connect the positive power wire (White) to the supplied breaker and connect the breaker and ground wire to the battery terminals (FIG 41 & FIG 42).

Installation

Once all bolts are started, tighten all roof mounting bolts down evenly. Reinstall the front and rear headliner sections along with the front switch panel using the OEM hardware and panel clips. Use a box knife to trim the front headliner as shown below for a clean finished appearance (**FIG 43**).

Test the lights, speakers and all factory options including rear bed light, windshield wiper motor and sprayer. Enjoy your new Thumper Fab Audio Roof.
