

#### **Removing OEM Bed Hinge Clamps**

First, start by removing both bed hinge clamps using a 13mm socket/wrench. Remove the locknuts, remove the clamps, and set them to the side (**FIG 1**).

#### Install the Mount Brackets

Next, you will need to lift the bed up slightly using the bed actuator and by lifting the rear end of the bed by hand. The bed needs to be lifted just enough to slip the mount bracket upward onto the threaded studs and over the bed hinge cylinder (**FIG 2**).

#### Re-install OEM Bed Hinge Clamps

After both mount brackets have been installed into place, re-install the bed hinge clamp and oem locknuts that were previously removed. DO NOT fully tighten these bolts yet. Take up as much slack in them as possible, but the mounts need to remain slightly loose until installation is complete (**FIG 3**).

#### **Installing Main Bumper Body**

Fasten the lights to the bumper body using hardware and tools provided in the light bar box, if light option was selected (**FIG 4**) Mount the light bar covers using 8 x #8-32 x1/2" socket cap screws and 8 x #8-32 nylon lock nuts (**FIG 5**).

#### **Installing Main Bumper Body**

Lift the main bumper body up into place by placing it over the ends of both rear mount brackets. Loosely fasten it with the (10) 3/8" Button Head Bolts, M8 washers, and M8 locknuts (**FIG 6**)

#### **Drilling Through Bed**

After the mount brackets and main bumper body have been installed, loosely, you will then need to drill through the bed, using the open holes on the mount brackets and a template. (FIG 7 & FIG 8)

Next, run the M8 x 70mm bolts down through the top of the bed and then fasten with the M8 washer and M8 locknut.

After both bolts have been installed and make sure bed is pulled rearward as much as possible, start with the first oem locknuts that you removed first, then working through all hardware in the assembly. Tighten all hardware.

#### **Install Rubber Threaded Bumpers**

Remove the (2) lower M6 Screws that fasten the exhaust shield onto the unit using a 10mm socket. Thread the rubber bumper into holes in frame and tighten by hand. These bumpers will help stop the bumper when dumping the bed with the elctric lift (**FIG 9 & FIG 10**).



#### **Light Wiring (OPTIONAL)**




FIG 11 - Wiring Harness Breakdown

Breakdown of wiring harness supplied with light option is shown below (**FIG 11**).

Plug the harness into the light bars mounted in the bumper and route wiring towards the front of the vheicle. Be sure to avoid any spinning or hot components that may cause damage to the harness (**FIG 12**).

#### **Light Wiring (OPTIONAL)**

Route the wiring into hood compartment and plug the pulse bar plug into an open slot on the pulse bar (**FIG 13**).






FIG 14 & FIG 15 - Wire Swtch and Install in Dash

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

Route switch wiring through the firewall and select open slot in dash to run the wires though before connecting wires to switch with blue wire on top, white wire in the middle, and black wire on the bottom terminal and install switch into slot in dash (**FIG 14 & FIG 15**).
